Coordination by Statute

- The WV Infrastructure & Jobs Development Council was created in 1994 by the WV Legislature.
- Section 31-15A-5a of the “Infrastructure Act” requires that “No project sponsor may apply for or receive any loan, loan guarantee, grant or other funding assistance for a project or infrastructure project from any state infrastructure agency (i) unless the project sponsor requiring the funding assistance first submits a completed preliminary application to the council...”

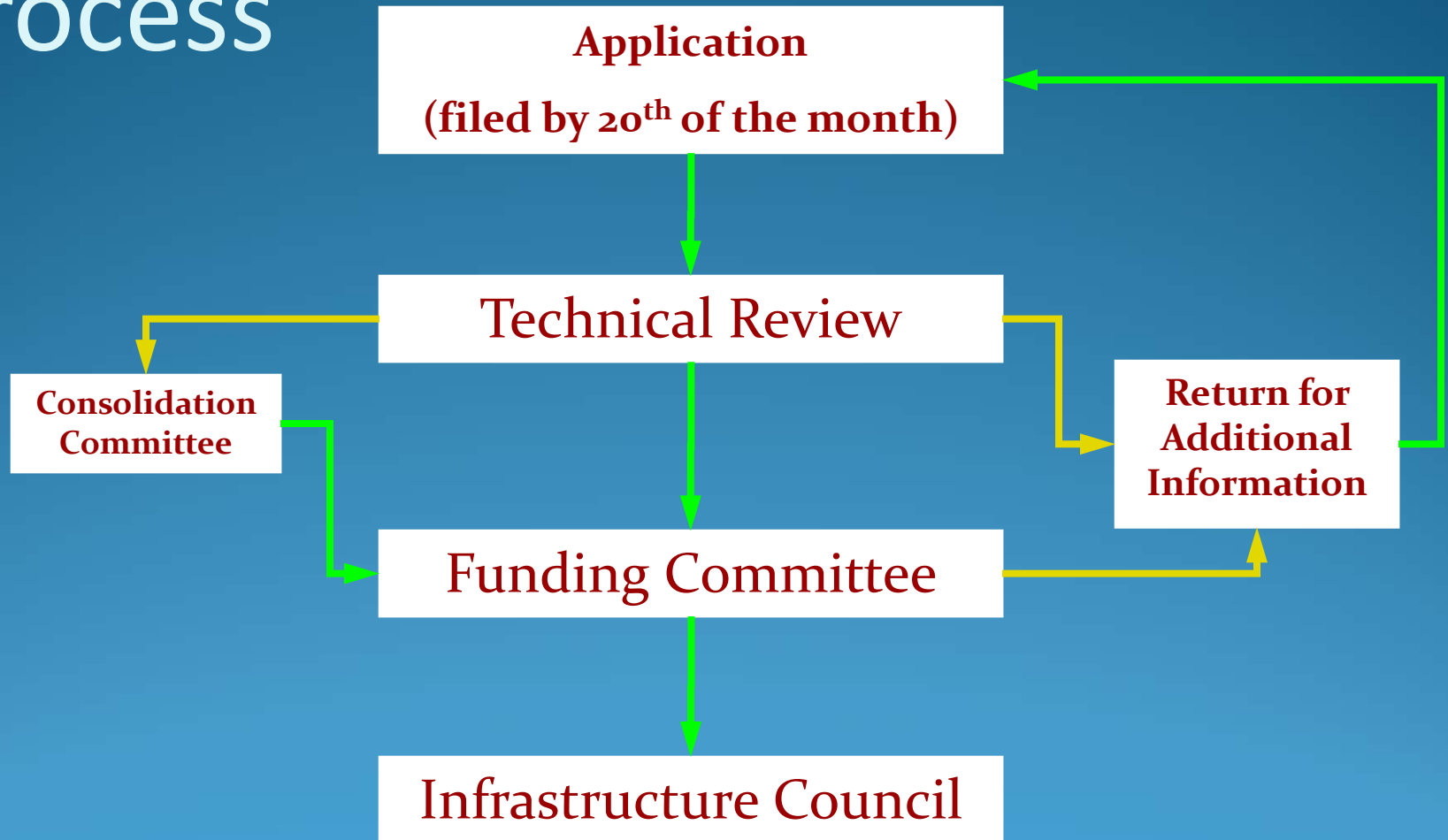

Process



Technical Review

- The committee reviews the application and engineering report in accordance with Chapter 31, Article 15A to determine if the application is:
 - A. Consistent with the intent of the act and is the most cost effective, environmentally sound alternative, or
 - B. Not consistent with the act and may not be most cost effective, environmentally sound alternative, or
 - C. Same as (A) above except certain issues need to be addressed prior to design and construction as attached comments indicate.

Technical Review Recommendation

- Based on their review, the committee makes a recommendation of either:
 - A. The Funding Committee needs to review the proposed sources of funding to determine the best mix of grant and/or loan funds in accordance with applicable guidelines, or
 - B. The Funding Committee should recommend to the Council the proposed project and its funding plan, or
 - C. The Funding Committee does not need to review the funding assumptions on the project because of deficiencies in the engineering report. The proposed project funding should be denied until technical comments have been resolved, or
 - D. This Project should be referred to the Consolidation Committee.

Consolidation Committee

- To review applications referred by the technical review committees
- To assess whether the proposed project encourages effective and efficient consolidation...
- To make a recommendation to the Funding Committee that the project should or should not be funded.
