Projects Recommended to Pursue Infrastructure Fund Assistance: Anstead, Town of – Sys Imprvs (New application)

Kathy Emery described the request, and it is technically feasible.

The Technical Review and Funding Committee recommends the Town of Ansted pursue a \$1,500,000 CWSRF Principal Forgiveness, a \$721,000 CWSRF Loan (0.25%, 40 yrs, 0.25% AF), and a \$1,000,000 IJDC Grant for an estimated project cost of \$3,221,000.

Marie Prezioso moved that the recommendation be approved, John Risenweber seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Benwood, City of – Sys Improvs IV (New application)

Kathy Emery described the request, and it is technically feasible.

The Technical Review and Funding Committee recommends the City of Benwood pursue a \$2,000,000 CWSRF Principal Forgiveness Loan, and a \$600,000 IJDC Grant for an estimated project cost of \$2,600,000.

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The Technical Review and Funding Committee recommends the Bluewell PSD pursue a \$2,000,000 AML Grant, a \$2,000,000 CWSRF Principal Forgiveness Loan, a \$11,940,000 (\$1,380,00 for design) CWSRF Loan (0.25%, 40 yrs, 0.25% AF), and a \$1,000,000 IJDC Grant for an estimated project cost of \$16,940,000.

Grant for an estimated cost of \$14,764,000.
