Belle, Town of-Sys imprvs II (Engineering fee waiver)

2024S-2635

Jason Billups described the request.

The Technical Review and Funding Committee recommends the engineering fee waiver request for total engineering fees be approved for the Town of Belle.

Jason Billups moved that the recommendation be approved, Jonathan Fowler seconded the motion. The Motion passed.

Capon Bridge, Town of-Line repl II (Engineering fee waiver)

The Technical Review and Funding Committee recommends the engineering fee waiver request for total engineering fees be approved for the Town of Capon Bridge.

Jason Billups described the request and the application was technical feasible.

The Technical Review and Funding Committee recommends the Town of Masontown pursue a \$1,000,000 IJDC grant, and a \$2,000,000 CWSRF PF for a total estimated project cost of \$3,000,000.

Kathy Emery moved that the recommendation be approved, Jonathan Fowler seconded the motion. The Motion passed.

Nitro, City of-Walker St storm sewer imprvs (Application upd incl cost & funding chg) 2024SS-2548 Jason Billups described the request and the application was technical feasible.

The Technical Review and Funding Committee recommends the City of Nitro pursue a \$2,888,000 Congressionally Directed Spending grant, a \$722,000 CDS match, a \$500,000 CWSRF PF loan, a \$325,000 Nitro contribution, and a \$800,000 WDA EEGF for an estimated project cost of \$5,235,000

Jason Billups moved that the recommendation be approved, Jonathan Fowler seconded the motion. The Motion passed.

RMS PSD-Glen Rogers WWTP imprvs (New application)

Jason Billups described the request and the application was technical feasible.

The Technical Review and Funding Committee recommends the Ravencliff McGraws Saulsville PSD pursue a \$500,000 CWSRF PF loan, \$1,500,000 CWSRF PF loan, a \$800,000 CDS, a \$1,900,000 ARC grant, a \$1,000,000 IJDC grant, and a \$25,000 Wyoming County Commission grant for an estimated project cost of \$5,725,000.

Jason Billups moved that the recommendation be approved, Jonathan Fowler seconded the motion. The Motion passed.

WATER PROJECTS

Ellenboro, Town of-Highland Rdg ext, 22 cust (Tbld application until Feb 25th)

Jason Billups described the request and the application was technical feasible.

The Technical Review and Funding Committee recommends the Town of Ellenboro pursue a \$887,500 DWTRF PF loan and a \$887,500 IJDC grant for an estimated project cost of \$1,775,000.

Meredith Vance moved that the recommendation be approved, Jonathan Fowler seconded the motion. The Motion passed.

Ice Run PSD-Carolina line repl (New application)

Jason Billups described the request and the application was technical feasible.

The Technical Review and Funding Committee recommends the Ice Run PSD pursue a \$1,262,000 DWTRF loan (1.75%, 30 yrs, 0.25% AF), a \$1,000,000 DWTRF PF loan, and a \$500,000 IJDC grant for an estimated project cost of \$2,762,000.

Meredith Vance moved that the recommendation be approved, Jonathan Fowler seconded the motion. The Motion passed.

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Pennsboro, City of-Highlands/Bonds Ck ext, 70 cust (Tbld application until Feb 25th) 2024W-2630 Jason Billups described the request and the application was technical feasible.

The Technical Review and Funding Committee recommends the application be returned for the applicant (Pennsboro) to address the technical review comments including working with the funding programs to ensure that a viable funding scenario is proposed upon resubmittal.

The Technical Review and Funding Committee recommends the City of Benwood receive a \$27,500 IJDC (match provided by Benwood) preapplication funding assistance (PFA) binding commitment for pilot study of treatment technologies.

Brooke Co PSD-Drovers Inn ext, 15 cust (Binding commitment ext)
