Branchland-Midkiff PSD-Line repl & conn W Hamlin (New application)

The Technical Review and Funding Committee recommends the Branchland-Midkiff PSD be eligible to pursue a \$370,000 CDS, a\$92,500 CDS match, a \$1,500,000 ARC grant, a \$330,000 USDA grant, and a \$334,500 USDA loan (3.25%, 38 yrs) for an estimated project cost of \$2,627,000.
